# New Erasmus+ project launched!

Reinforcement of the Framework for Experiential Education in Healthcare in Serbia

Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency of the European Commission (EACEA) has announced the results of the Erasmus+ Programme - Capacity building in higher education Call EAC/A04/2014. Among the projects selected for funding is ReFEEHS project coordinated by the University of Belgrade, Serbia.

ReFEEHS project will be realized as a three years project starting from October 15, 2015 with the approved budget of 802.737 EUR.

ReFEEHS Consortium is built as a partnership between the schools of Health Sciences (Medicine, Pharmacy, Dentistry and Nursing) of the four universities from the Republic of Serbia and four EU universities sharing the common interest in continuous improvement of curricula and academic mobility and exchange.

Project Objectives are founded on the relevant EU and national regulatory and professional guidance documents.

ReFEEHS project is aimed at modernization of health sciences curricula, improved level of professional competencies of health science students, improved teaching competence of academic staff and teacher practitioners, improved employability of health science graduates, harmonization with EU practice and polices and improved patient health care based on interprofessional collaborative practice.

**Project Objectives** 

- Reinforcement and modernization of experiential education (students professional practice) in health professionals education.
- Introduction of interprofessional teaching and learning, including new joint interprofessional courses for all health science students.
- Teaching competence development of academic staff and teacher practitioners, including introduction of the Teaching Certificate study programme.

Developed and updated experiential and interprofessional curricula will be delivered in the third project year at the four major Serbian universities where a total of around 2700 health sciences students will be exposed to new or upgraded curricula.

Consortium partners are looking forward to wider engagement and contribution from all the interested parties. Health sciences students, practitioners and regulators are invited to bring in new ideas and take proactive role in project realization.
